



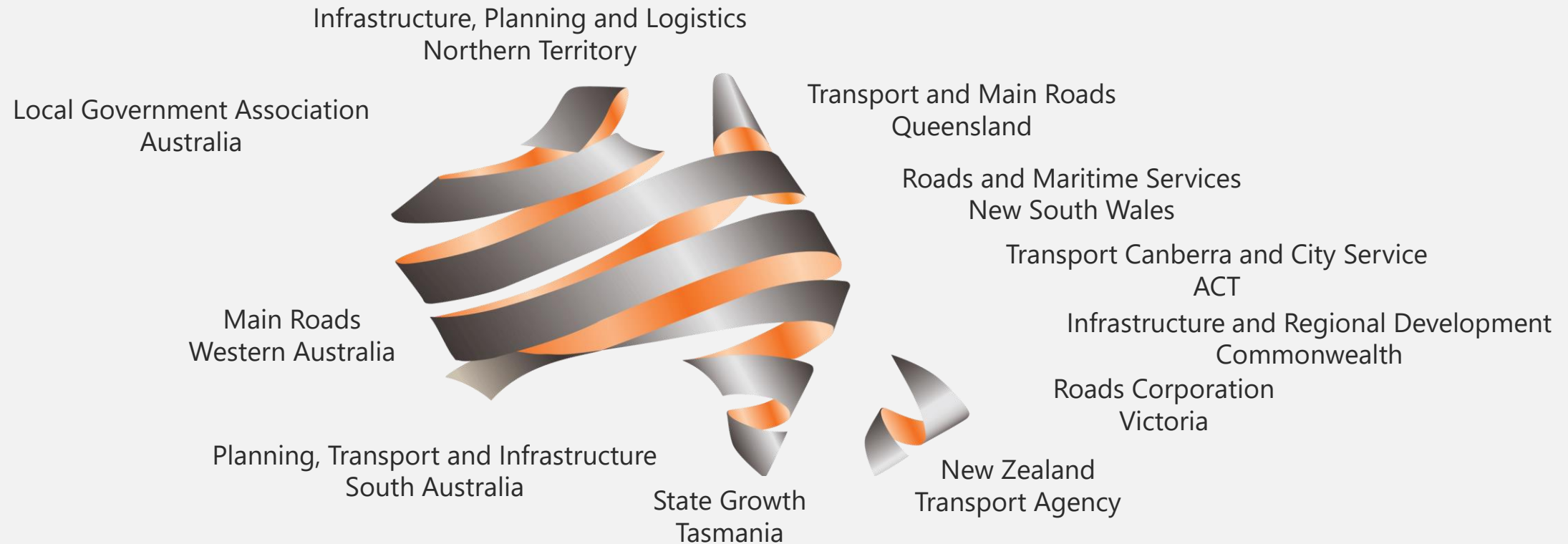

- Expert – “Rated up there as some of the most deficient in road work set-ups I've seen”
- NT DIPL admitted
 - it failed its duty of care
 - there had been a failure to ensure managing contractor complied with the approved traffic control diagram
 - conducted random checks but believed it could delegate responsibility to ensure safety
- Coroner - that wasn't good enough, that the department had a duty of care to the public

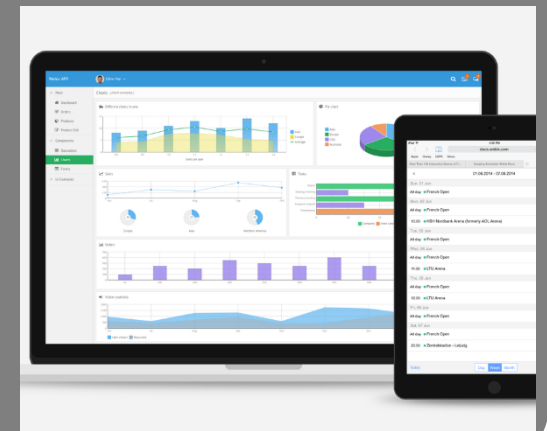
